

## Early Returns

The Federal Aviation Administration's Airspace Flow Program already has resulted in a significant reduction in flight delays across the country. In fact, based on preliminary numbers, there were 10,822 fewer delays overall during July 2006 than July 2005, with weather accounting for the bulk of the delays during both months.
