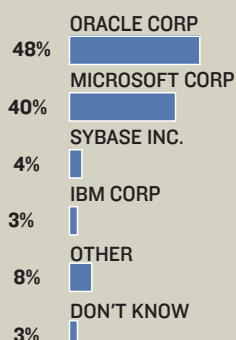


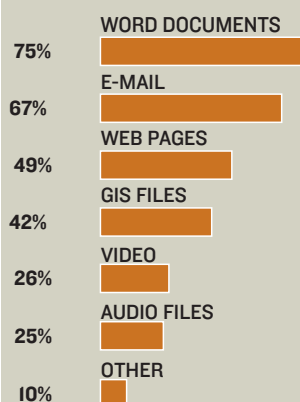

Word, e-mail, Web documents plentiful

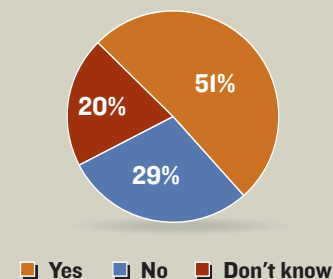
What data formats do you store?



» Words are the real currency of government, so it's no surprise that Microsoft Word documents and e-mail messages were the dominant data formats.

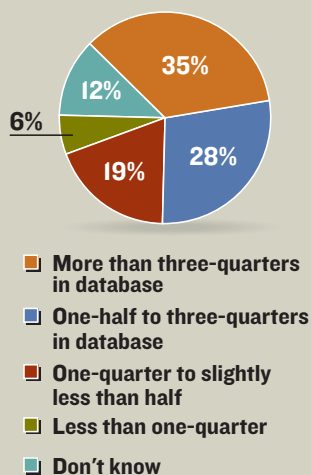
Looking to enterprise storage consolidation

Databases home to most data

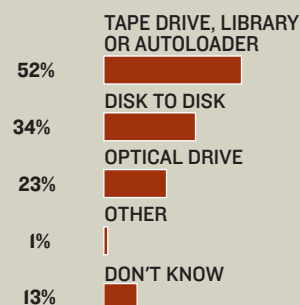
What portion of your data is in a database format versus other, unstructured formats?

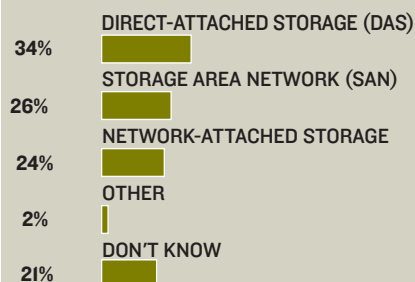
Backup is a tale of the tape

What types of technology do you use to back up critical data?*



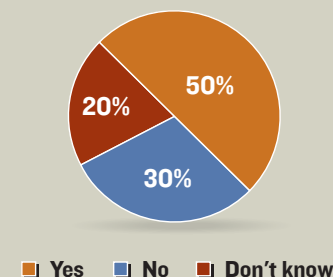
Direct approach to storage
