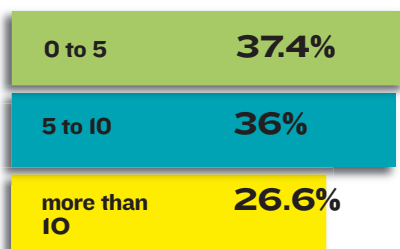


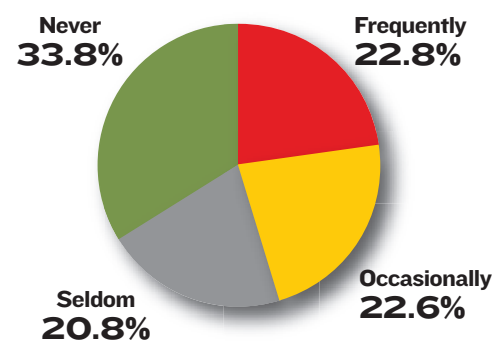
Shared systems

In December, GCN electronically surveyed about 450 government readers on the identification management practices of their agencies. Here is how they responded.

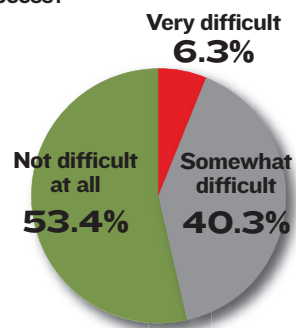
How many passwords do you keep for work-related purposes?



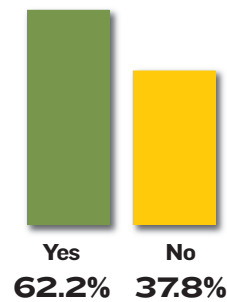
How often do you have to log in to a government computer system that is not run by the agency you work for?



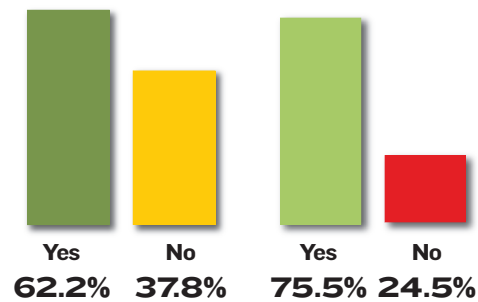
If you do have to log in to another agency's system, how difficult is this process?



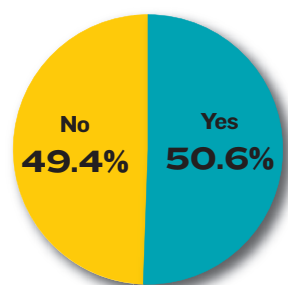
Does your agency have network systems that are used by employees at other agencies?
